On the 20-year anniversary of his groundbreaking masterpiece *Roger & Me* (1989), Michael Moore's *Capitalism: A Love Story* comes home to the issue he's been examining throughout his career: the disastrous impact of corporate dominance on the everyday lives of Americans (and by default, the rest of the world). With both humor and outrage, Michael Moore's *Capitalism: A Love Story* explores a taboo question: What is the price that America pays for its love of capitalism? Years ago, that love seemed so innocent. Today, however, the American dream is looking more like a nightmare as families pay the price with their jobs, their homes and their savings. Moore takes us into the homes of ordinary people whose lives have been turned upside down; and he goes looking for explanations in Washington, DC and elsewhere.
