



Corzine Sneak Attack on Layoff Rights!

On Wednesday, 3/25 Governor Corzine's Puppet Political Hacks on the Civil Service Commission unanimously passed "emergency" temporary layoff rules without public notification or hearing, claiming that going through the legal Rule Change process would place the state in "imminent peril."

The new emergency rules are valid for 60 days and allow for "temporary" layoffs of one "or more" days with no limitations. No seniority, no bumping, no collective bargaining. All of this was done through an extraordinary, undemocratic process.

During the next 60 days, the Governor and the Civil Service Commission will attempt to make these rules permanent.

The CWA FIGHT BACK plan.

1. We will go to court to fight the illegal temporary rules. We are also filing an Unfair Labor Practice Charge. We will need members to come to court and to the Public Employment Relations Commission when the hearings are held. We will announce these dates ASAP.
2. We will take every action to fight these rules becoming permanent. We will need EVERY worker to come to the public hearings to protest this railroading of our rights.
3. ALL OUT FOR WORKSITE PICKETING against layoffs, wage freezes and furloughs on April 7th. EVERY member on the picket line. Every worksite involved. See your steward for information.
