Is This "Shared Sacrifice?"

Lower Wage State Worker

\$37,000

Cost of 12 Unpaid Furlough Days

\$1,702 **4.6% Pay Cut** **Plus**

Foregone Wage Increase

\$1,295 **3.5% Pay Cut**

=

\$2,997 8.1% Total Pay Cut

Average State Worker Salary

\$51,000

Furlough Days = \$2,354 **Plus**

Foregone Wage Increase = \$1,785

= \$4,139 **Total 8.1% Pay Cut**

High Wage State Worker

\$75,000

Furlough Days = \$3,450 **Plus**

Foregone Wage Increase = \$2,625

= \$6,075 **Total 8.1% Pay Cut**

High Income Families

\$300,000

Gov. Corzine's Proposed Tax Increase

\$625 (.11% of total income)*
